The Rehabilitation Unit at the Sydney Adventist Hospital (the San) provides an exciting opportunity to work in a new unit with first-class facilities and a great team of medical, nursing and allied health staff.

The San is a tertiary referral hospital and is the largest private, not-for-profit hospital in NSW, working closely with public hospitals, including Hornsby, Westmead and Royal North Shore hospitals. The hospital has recently been extensively redeveloped, and is now a facility with 550 beds and 24 operating theatres.

The San Rehabilitation Service is co-located with the acute hospital with 47 beds providing inpatient rehabilitation in addition to its Day Only Rehabilitation program. Trainees work alongside Rehabilitation Specialists and you will be provided with the opportunity to see a diverse and interesting mix of cases. There is no on-call for weekend or after-hours. Part-time or job-share arrangements may be considered upon application.

- RACP AFRM trainee or equivalent
- Demonstrated competency in clinical skills including effective assessment, care planning care provision, case management and management of clinical emergencies

- Demonstrated ability to work within a multidisciplinary team environment

Desirable

- Clinical experience in rehabilitation, care of persons with aged related conditions, and treatment of chronic and complex health problems.
- Experience and demonstrated ability in supervising junior medical officers
