- Screening / Fluoroscopic Procedures
- Image-guided Biopsies / FNA's / Joint Injections / Drainages

San Ultrasound for Women

San Ultrasound for Women provides diagnostic imaging services specifically for women.

Our doctors are experienced obstetricians and gynaecologists who provide a professional and caring approach. Our sonographers are accredited and also specialize in diagnostic imaging.

We provide pregnancy ultrasounds for:

- Dating
- Nuchal translucency
- Morphology
- Growth and wellbeing screening
- 3D/4D, cervical length screening and prenatal diagnosis
- Chorionic Villus sampling (CVS)
- Amniocentesis
- Cell free fetal DNA (cffDNA)

We also provide gynaecological ultrasounds for women with:

- Mirenas – Mirena location, insertion and removal

- Endometriosis
- Pelvic pain
- Period problems
- Infertility
- Polycystic ovaries
- Post-menopausal bleeding and incontinence and prolapse uterus

These examinations sometimes lead to pelvic procedures such as Sonohysterograms and Hysterosalpingo-Contrast-Sonography (HYCOSY).

Northern Nuclear Medicine

With state-of-the-art facilities and personal attention and service, Northern Nuclear Medicine provides a comprehensive range of diagnostic nuclear medicine services for patients in Sydney Adventist Hospital and the local community.

Services include:

- PET scans - for a range of oncological applications
- Stress Sesta MIBI myocardial perfusion studies (with exercise, persantin or dobutamine)
- Bone scans - for stress or occult fractures, bony metastases, arthritis etc
- Lung scans - for pulmonary embolism
- Biliary/gall bladder/HIDA scan - for evaluation of acute or chronic cholecystitis
- Gastric emptying studies
- Gastro-oesophageal reflux studies
- Renal scans - for evaluation of obstruction, renal artery stenosis
- Thyroid scans Parathyroid scans - for evaluation of thyrotoxicosis and hyperparathyroidism
- Gallium scans - for evaluation of occult infection
- Lymphoscintigraphy and sentinel lymph node localisation for breast cancer and melanoma
- Bone densitometry measurements for diagnosis of osteoporosis
- I-131 treatment for thyrotoxicosis
