- Infertility
- Menorrhagia (heavy periods)
- Dysmenorrhea and other menstrual problems
- Endometriosis
- Fibroids and uterine tumours
- Ovarian cysts
- Prolapse and urinary incontinence
- Pelvic inflammatory disease
- Cancers of the reproductive organs (see Women's Cancer Services sheet for further information)

Medical, Surgical and Procedural Options

Our medical, surgical and procedural specialists treat a range of conditions. The range of surgical and procedural options used by our specialists at the San allows the specialists to choose the most appropriate treatment for their patients:

- Open surgery
- Laparoscopy
- Uterine Artery Embolisation
- Da Vinci Robot

Our surgeons have access to fully equipped modern operating theatres with ready access to other medical and surgical specialties.

Emergency Care

Sydney Adventist Hospital operates the largest private emergency care facility in New South Wales. We offer 24 x 7 emergency care for gynaecological emergencies with on call surgeons. On call ultrasound sessions are offered with on-site sonographers on both weekend days.

Fertility Treatment

IVFAustralia operates a fertility clinic on-site providing consulting and monitoring services.

Sydney Adventist Hospital delivers a full range of diagnostic services for patients including:

San Ultrasound for Women

- Pelvic Ultrasound
- Sonohysterography
- HYCOSY procedure for infertility

San Radiology

- General Ultrasound
- CT (High Definition, Low Dose)
- MRI (including high-resolution imaging of the uterus and cervix)
- Interventional Procedures
 - Fine Needle Aspiration / Biopsies (lymph glands, pelvic masses etc.)
 - Uterine Fibroid Embolisation (UFE) (treatment of benign fibroid disease)
 - Transarterial Chemo-Embolisation (TACE)
 - Selective Internal Radiation Therapy (SIRT), usually in the treatment of metastatic liver disease
